### **Yolo Community Foundation Hosts Yolo County Nonprofit Leadership Roundtable**

**Woodland, Ca.** – Yolo Community Foundation will be hosting its first Yolo County Nonprofit Leadership Roundtable Wednesday, March 7, 2007 from Noon - 2:00 p.m. at Heidrick Ag History Center. All Yolo County Nonprofit Leaders are invited to attend.

The topic for the Roundtable will be Community Impact Planning. Community Impact Planning is a cooperative asset-based approach to building a strong community. The nonprofit leaders will discuss ways that nonprofit groups can share physical, community and human resources that organizations can share.

Many local organizations share similar missions and can greatly benefit from working together. Time will also be reserved for brainstorming and support for solutions to common nonprofit issues.

“The Nonprofit Resource Center in Sacramento has successfully hosted similar meetings in Sacramento for years,” explained Cath Posehn, Executive Director of Yolo Community Foundation. “We see this as augmentation to their efforts as a number of smaller Yolo County nonprofits do not have Executive Directors would not be allowed to attend the “Executive Director only” meetings. In addition, many Yolo County nonprofits often can not afford the block of time it would take once a month for the drive to and from Sacramento in addition to the meeting time itself. We also see this as a time to focus on issues that specifically relate to Yolo County and its needs.”
